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Introduction of China Care Fund

China Care Fund (“CCF”) was founded in 1993 by a group of Hong Kongers who cared about education for young people in rural areas on the motherland. CCF promotes mutual understanding between young people on both sides of the border; provides education to those who were prevented from going to school because of poverty and/or calamities.

Under the leadership of Mr. Arthur Tso, our current Chairman, CCF was incorporated and formally became a registered charity on 26th August 2002. CCF further acquired the official title of a Foreign NGO registered under mainland legislation in 2017 and formally opened its representative office in Guangzhou on 6th December 2018.

China Care Fund – Rural Talents Revitalization "Senior High School Programme"

CCF assists senior high school students because they receive little financial assistance from government in the 3 years leading up to their senior high school exam.

With a few exceptions, all of the assisted students are from rural villages. Some are from single parent families or are orphans, many suffer from various diseases. All of them fall within the definition of "poverty" promulgated in their respective locality and live in financial hardship.

As at to date, a total of **RMB 92 million** had been expended in assisting 12,891 senior high school students in 8 provinces, namely Guangdong, Guangxi, Guizhou, Gansu, Qinghai, Yunnan, Jiangxi and Xinjiang.

When the new school year begins on 1st September 2026, CCF will take on a total of **680 new senior 1** students making the total number of students receiving assistance through this programme in Yunnan, Jiangxi and Xinjiang Uygur Autonomous Region, 2,029.

From the money you pay us, each assisted student will be paid ¥3,000 as contribution to their living expenses. Also from your money, ¥650 will be spent on providing each student with an annual gift of things they will need e.g. blankets and warm clothing; one eye check in their 3 years of senior high school and eyeglasses if needed and relief in case of calamities. Workshops for the students will also be conducted by our team of qualified social workers. CCF and our donors will visit our students regularly. Where plausible, CCF will act as messenger of messages between donors and students. Before assistance is confirmed, CCF will conduct home visits to each and every one of its assisted students to ensure accuracy of the information provided.

To cover the increasing running costs of the above services, CCF seeks from you donation of ¥500 / student / year of assistance. We deduct this donation from the money you pay us.

Donors are encouraged to visit our students and many of them do.

Donors are obligated to stay with the programme for 3 years.

2026 Assistance Breakdown

Students are assisted for three years. Assistance fees may be paid:

- 1) **annually**, in which case the second and third payments may vary (due to currency fluctuation or fees adjustment) in the second and third years; or
- 2) **in one lump sum**, being three times the 2026 assistance fee fixed and set out below.

Each student assisted will receive:

- a sum presenting living expenses, currently fixed at ¥ 3,000
- an annual gift of necessary items, one eye check in their 3 years of senior high school and eyeglasses, if necessary, relief in case of calamities, care services provided by CCF including workshops, mail services, and our visits, in the total worth of ¥650

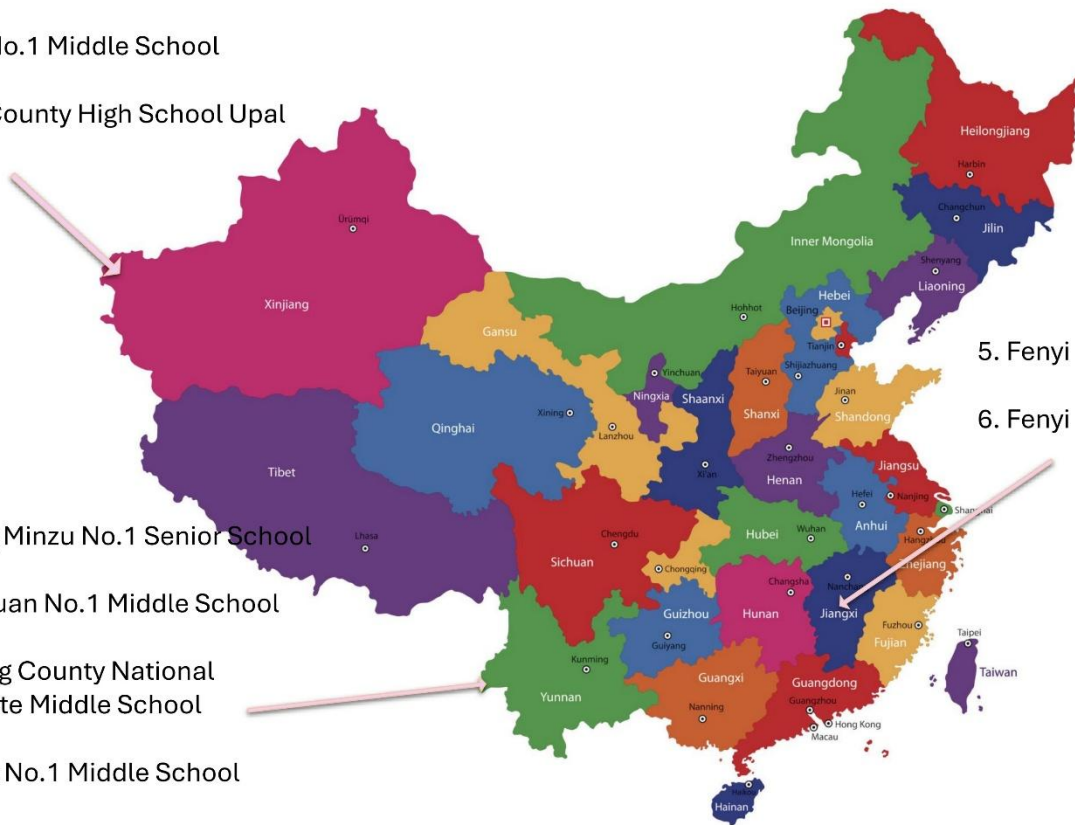

Dehong Minzu No.1 Senior School	
Location:	West of Yunnan Province.
History:	Established in 1952, it is one of the key senior schools in Yunnan province.
Teacher & students:	3,022 students in 58 classes.
Assistance:	For 2025-2026, a total of 2,002 or roughly 66% of the student population are “underprivileged”. CCF has assisted over 869 such students since 2018.



Longchaun No.1 Middle School	
Location:	West of Yunnan Province.
History:	Established in 1958, it is one of the key senior schools in Yunnan province.
Teacher & students:	2,952 students in 54 classes.
Assistance:	For 2025-2026, a total of 2,208 or roughly 75% of the student population are “underprivileged”. CCF has assisted over 451 such students since 2022.



Yingjiang County National Complete Middle School

Location:	West of Yunnan Province.
History:	Established in 2016, it is one of the key senior schools in Yunnan province.
Teacher & students:	There are 1,925 students in 35 classes.
Assistance:	For 2025-2026, a total of 646 or roughly 34% of the student population are “underprivileged”. CCF has assisted over 229 such students since 2024.



Lianghe No.1 Middle School	
Location:	West of Yunnan Province.
History:	Established in 1956, it is one of the key senior schools in Yunnan province.
Teacher & students:	There are 2,432 students in 48 classes.
Assistance:	For 2025-2026, a total of 1,151 or roughly 47% of the student population are “underprivileged”. CCF has assisted over 440 such students since 2023.



Fenyi Middle School	
Location:	Situated at Jiangxi. Fenyi prefecture.
History:	Built in 1940, now one of the finest in Jiangxi province.
Teacher & students:	Has 66 classes, a total of 3,430 students. 1,200 senior 1, 1,200 senior 2 and 1,030 senior 3.
Assistance:	16% of senior high school division or 543 students have hardship. CCF has assisted 99 of these students in its 1 st year of providing assistance.



Fenyi No. 4 Middle School	
Location:	Situated at Jiangxi. Fenyi prefecture.
History:	Built in 2023, a public senior high school.
Teacher & students:	Has 80 classes, a total of 4,150 students. 1,467 Senior 1, 1,467 Senior 2 and 1,216 Senior 3.
Assistance:	16% of senior high school division or 665 students have hardship. CCF has taken on 91 of these students in its 1 st year of providing assistance.



Kashgar City, Shufu County, Shufu No.1 Middle School

Location:	Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region Kashi City.
History:	Built in 1956 now one of the finest in Kashi.
Teacher & students:	Has 90 classes, a total of 4,801 students. 1,200 senior 1, 1,877 senior 2 and 1,724 senior 3.
Assistance:	100% of Senior high school division or 4,801 students have hardship. CCF has taken on 98 of these students in its 1 st year of providing assistance.



Shufu County High School Upal	
Location:	Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region Kashi City.
History:	Built in 1958 with its senior high school division being moved to Guangzhou New City, Shufu County, Kashgar Prefecture. A public senior high school.
Teacher & students:	Has 22 classes with a total of 1,063 students. 500 senior 1, 297 senior 2 and 266 senior 3.
Assistance:	100% of Senior high school division or 1,063 students have hardship. CCF has taken on 90 of these students in its 1 st year of providing assistance.
